- I. The *Journal of Russian Philology* is an academic journal, will be published in June. Contributions written in Chinese, English or Russian are welcomed on all topics related to the Russian language, Russian literature, and Russian culture and are accepted all year round.
- II. Previously published articles or multiple submissions of the same article, as well as translations, lecture notes and reportorial writing will not be accepted.
- III. Please provide real name and indicate affiliations, job title, contact address, phone number and email address when submitting manuscripts.
- IV. Each manuscript is limited to 12,000 words. To ensure uniformity of appearance, footnotes should be typed at the bottom of the page. The first page of the manuscript should be the title page and should contain the manuscript's title, author's name, abstract (limited to 300 words), and key words (all written in both "Chinese & English" or "Russian & English"). The main text of the manuscript should begin on the second page (format guidelines attached).
- V. Please send an electronic copy in Word and PDF formats.
- VI. All submissions are subject to anonymous review by two scholars with expertise in fields relevant to the subject of the manuscript. Contributors will be notified of review results within two months. The Journal reserves the right to make editorial changes where necessary. Contributors not requiring editorial assistance should specify so in advance.
- VII. Contributors shall assume responsibility for all information contained in the published article.
- VIII. If any submission being accepted by *Journal of Russian Philology*, the authors agree to grant *Journal of Russian Philology* to sublicense National Central Library or any other database provider to reproduce, transmit publicly by Internet, download, print and browse by authorized users. The submissions may be changed in order to meet the requirement of such database.
- IX. Unpublished manuscripts will not be returned. As no compensation is paid to contributors, one copy of the Journal's current issue and five off-prints of the

article will be provided free of charge to contributors once published.
